CHALLENGE PATTERNS

All challenges will complete the same Utility and/or Time Trial Patterns

Utility Pattern U1

Time Trial Pattern TT1

Cattle work will be scored the same for all Challenges that include this phase. The cattle work will be scored with a maximum of 100 points. 25 possible points cut out (camp) section and 75 points for the arena work. 25 points for the first peg, 25 points for the second peg, 25 points for the gate or third peg. Time limit is 40 seconds. The committee reserves the right to decide on the maximum and minimum number of cattle in the cut out.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- * All people entering the grounds, competitors and handlers do so voluntarily. Neither the organizing committee nor The Australian Stock Horse Society accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury to horse or rider, spectator, or any other person or equipment whatsoever.
- * The committee has the right to alter, delete, postpone or change in part or entirely the program or the weekend of competition.
- * Entry fee for each challenge is \$40.
- * Prize money for each OVERALL challenge place getters - 1st \$100, 2nd \$80, 3rd \$60, 4th \$40 and 5th \$20. There is also prize money for each individual challenge event 1st \$15, 2nd \$10 and 3rd \$5
- * ASHS Temporary memberships are to be paid for separately on the day if needed.
- * Adult membership for the weekend is \$40 and Youth (under 18) is \$15. Anyone that is not an ASHS member has to fill in and pay for a temporary membership for the weekend BEFORE you ride.
- * Horses in the All Breeds and 8 & U13 Challenges are the only ones exempt from being ASHS registered.
- * All horses entered in each challenge must complete each event or forfeit all points gained.
- * The nominated horse must have the same rider in all phases of the challenge.
- * Young horses in the 3 and 4 year old horse challenges will take their age from 1st August and will be checked alongside their papers.
- * Riders must be suitably attired in accordance with the ASHS Handbook.
- * All horses competing must only use a snaffle bit with a smooth mouthpiece - no twisted wire bits or rough surfaces. No tie downs etc to be used in any phase. Bridle and saddle choice is personal preference, but must be safe for use.
- * Anyone displaying poor sportsmanship or being verbally abusive towards other competitors, committee members or volunteers will be asked to leave the grounds and further action taken. Anyone displaying acts of cruelty towards their horse or other members horses and any other livestock will be asked to leave the grounds and further action taken. All entry/camping money will not be refunded in these cases.
- * Judges decision is final. No protests will be entered into
- * All competitors under 18 years must wear an approved helmet and other riders are encouraged to do do. Riders under 18 years are not to handle or ride a colt or stallion.
- * Colts and stallions are to be double tied in a yard made from an electric fence or panels.
- * There are NO stables available. Power is LIMITED, please bring a generator. Toilets and showers are available.
- * Electric fences or panels are permitted.
- * Entry fees will NOT be refunded under any circumstances unless received in written form at least 72 hours before the event, with a vet/medical certificate.
- * Canteen will be available for Breakfast and lunch both days - No Bar.

BEFORE COMPETITION ON THE SATURDAY ALL RIDERS MUST SEE THE SECRETARY TO FINALISE PAPERWORK, PAYMENT AND COLLECT A WRIST BAND.

NO WRISTBAND = NO RIDING
