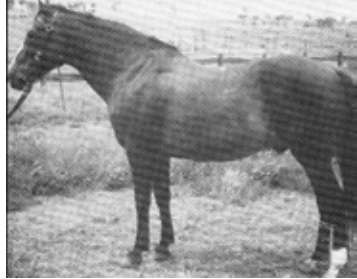

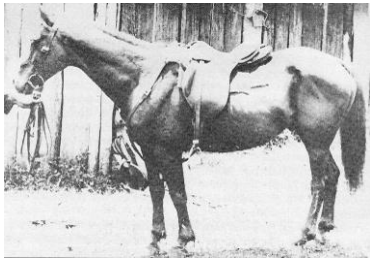

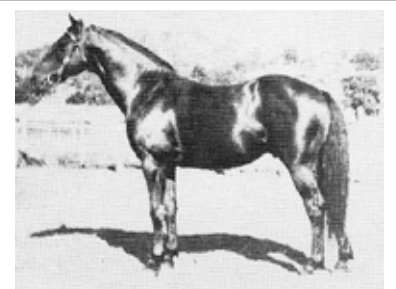
Later in that year, the Society's Board Room was established as the Hall of Fame, for the display of the Society's history and a conference room.
