Selection of Judges for the Australian Stock Horse Society National Show

The Board has approved the following criteria for selection of Judges for the Australian Stock Horse Society National Show.

1. Branches are requested to nominate competent accredited Judges for the National Show. The Branches to send in a list of Show (maximum 12) and Maiden Series Campdraft (maximum 4) Judges.
2. Any accredited Australian Stock Horse Judge who feels they have the experience and ability to judge at a National Show can self nominate to the National Show Committee with a current resume.
3. These lists from the Branches are amalgamated by Head Office.
4. Nominations from Branches are then submitted to the National Show Committee for selection after which resumes will be requested from nominees and also their availability to judge at the National Show. The aim of the National Show Committee is to select qualified Judges from all states where possible.
5. Judges are selected for the National Futurity first, as it needs two Judges per event, then those Judges will be utilised in different disciplines to avoid duplication.
6. National Show Committee will list the Judges in order of preference per category Led, Hack and Working. Head Office will notify the selected Judges of their judging appointments.
7. The National Show Committee will select the patterns for all events.
8. Head Office to send a letter to the selected Judges containing the terms of the contract regarding their engagement.

Time Plan

- The closing date for these nominations is Wednesday, 30th September 2015.
- Nominations from Branches or individuals will not be accepted after the closing date.
- If there are insufficient nominations of accredited competent Judges by this process the National Show Committee has the power to appoint further accredited Judges.
- National Show Committee meeting to be held October to go over the list and select the Judges for the National Show.
- Head Office to contact Judges by phone in order of list after National Show Committee has made their selection to confirm their availability.
- Judges will be finalised and printed on the National Show nomination forms.
- The National Show Committee has the power to change the Judges due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Maiden Series and Campdraft Judges will be selected by the same process. Judges must be accredited by one of the campdraft associations.
- Dressage Judges to be qualified EA Judges.
