Statutory Declaration for Reissue of Papers

REISSUE FEE

The 2019 Reissue Fee is \$45. The Member seeking reissue must be a financial Member of the Australian Stock Horse Society.

STATUTORY DECLARATION

A Statutory Declaration is a written statement declared to be true and signed in the presence of an authorised witness. Under the Act a person who wilfully makes a false statement in a Statutory Declaration is guilty of an offence. A Statutory Declaration must be made before a prescribed witness. The Australian Government does not appoint Justices of the Peace and has no responsibility for their administration. The various State and Territory Governments are responsible for their appointment and administration under the authority of relevant State and Territory legislation.

TO FIND A JUSTICE OF THE PEACE

The State government website may have a database for Justices of the Peace in your area with details of how to contact them. There are Justices of the Peace in most Australian suburbs and towns. Justices of the Peace are highly respected members of the community who play an important role in society.
