The Competition starts on 1st January and ends 31st December each year. The horse must be fully registered with the ASHS and owned by a financial Member of ASHS.

#### Rookie

Horse for Ladies and Mens - The horse must be 7yrs of age or under at the start of the year. The horse must be participating in its first or second season of polocrosse. A horse is considered to have participated in a season once it has played one game in a carnival in any grade. Please note: The horse must be ridden by a lady to be eligible for Ladies Rookie Horse and a man to be eligible for Mens Rookie Horse.

#### Open

Horse for Ladies, Mens & Juniors - The horse must be ridden by a lady to be eligible for Ladies Open Horse, a man to be eligible for Mens Open Horse and a Junior to be eligible for Juniors Open Horse.

Please return the Resume to your Polocrosse State Secretary on completion of the polocrosse season in your state. Please note: Queensland nominations must be with Polocrosse Zone Secretary by 30th July each. State Secretaries to endorse and forward to ASHS Head Office.
