ELIGIBILITY

A horse shall be eligible for registration in the **BASE REGISTRY** if it shall have one parent, or one grandparent, or two great grandparents registered as an Australian Stock Horse and denoted as being a Heritage Stock Horse.

Mares, fillies, stallions, colts and geldings are eligible.

Once registered, horses will be eligible for ASH events, awards and sales, providing the Registered Owner is a Financial Member of the Society.

STEPS FOR REGISTRATION

- 1 Horses must be branded owner, identification and year.
- 2 Horses must pass inspection by a Society Inspector.
- 3 Submit Application for Registration with ASH Breeding Certificate with required fees.
- Horses will be DNA profiled and parentage tested (if available)
- Mares, Fillies, Stallions and Colts will be Genetic Disorder Tested

HERITAGE STOCK HORSE

A Heritage Stock Horse is a horse that exhibits a minimum of 87.5% Australian Stock Horse heritage lineage. Heritage lineage descends from either the same breeds of horses ridden by the Australian Light Horse in World War I, or of the breeds existing in Australia prior to 1945.
