REGULATIONS AND ELIGIBLE EVENTS

- Each competitor must be a Financial Member of the Australian Stock Horse Society.
- One performance booklet is to be completed for each horse/rider combination.
- No limit to the number of horse/rider combinations.
- All horses must be registered and competition eligible with the Australian Stock Horse Society.
- The guardian of the competitor must sign a statement of legitimacy to verify all performance results in each booklet.
- Performances obtained in open or junior competition are accepted provided they are open to All Breeds or restricted to Australian Stock Horses. Performances at shows, rodeos, pony clubs, gymkhanas, etc are acceptable for this competition.
- Minimum performance for the Endurance Category is 40km.
- Performance booklets should be returned when fully completed and must be submitted within fourteen (14) days of the end of the calendar year.
- For multi-phase events please only include overall placings up to 3rd place.
