### **Rules and Conditions:**

- 1 All Horses competing must be registered with the Australian Stock Horse Society Ltd. Unregistered horses/ponies allowed only in under 13 years junior events
- 2 All riders/handlers/ must be ASHS members or a **\$50 day membership** will be payable, to cover insurance chargers.
- 3 Competitors must be able to produce a current ASHS membership card when requested.
- 4 No competitor under 18yrs may lead or ride a Stallion or Colt on the grounds or in classes during the Branch Show.
- 5 All Competitors must wear a current ASA Approved Safety Helmet and smooth soled riding boots, when mounted. All junior competitors must wear a current ASA approved helmet at all times when handling a horse.
- 6 The committee has the right to delete, defer or alter the program and have the right to refuse any entry.
- 7 Any person handling a horse must be an ASHS member or Day Member.
- 8 Electrical extension leads may be used; battery backup or generators to power camp sites are allowed.
- 9 Stallions and Colts are to be bitted or hobbled or double tied when not in a yard.
- 10 In classes stating Maiden Horse and Maiden Rider, both horse and rider never to have won any classes at any other show previously.
- 11 Gate to be closed at night.
- 12 Parents must take full responsibility for their children and ensure appropriate behavior and that the children do not go to areas of the grounds not involved with the facilities directly associated with the show.
- 13 Yards available at cost \$10/yard – please book on Event Secretary.
- 14 Rubbish bins are limited around the grounds. Please ensure the area is kept tidy and deposit rubbish in the bins where possible.
- 15 Competitors are required to clean up all manure, hay and feed to designated points around the grounds.
- 16 Newcomer Ridden Stock Horse- For horses not to have competed under saddle in any equestrian discipline prior to the 23/04/24- the start of the 2024-2025 Victorian ASH show season.
- 17 Maiden horse has not won a ridden hack or working class. Maiden rider has not won a ridden hack or working class.

Neither the organising committee, the Australian Stock Horse Society Ltd. or the Hexham Recreation Reserve accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury nor illness to horses, riders, beasts, ground spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

### **Protest Procedures:**

*The Judges' decision is final.*

- 14.1 Any competitor or exhibitor may lodge a complaint in writing to the (Show) Secretary of the Show Committee within 30 minutes of the completion of the event.
- 14.2 The complaint must be accompanied by a fee of \$50 (recommended by the Show Committee) and is refundable if the protest is upheld.
- 14.3 The complaint shall be heard by the Protest Committee and will be dealt with as the committee shall direct. The Protest Committee will consist of the Show Manager and 2 other members of the Show Committee.
- 14.4 The Protest Committee will deal with problems involving the show not covered by the rules of the ASHS Events Handbook.
- 14.5 All Complaints/Protests relating to swabbing of an exhibit on the day of the Show, the costs involved are the responsibility of the Protestor. Veterinarian, Lab testing fees and any relating costs. To be paid prior to a veterinarian being called to the event.

Other rules and regulations relating to complaints or protests are specifically covered in the ASHS Events Handbook Section 1 – Page 6 (20<sup>th</sup> November 2013).

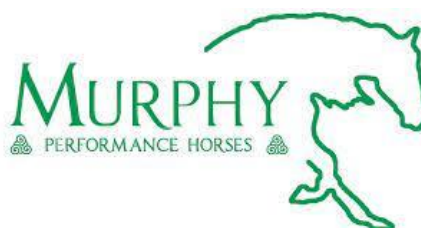
