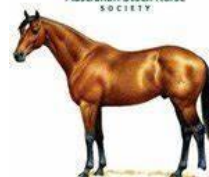

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The West Gippsland Branch of the Australian Stock Horse Society Limited Annual Show is conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of The Australian Stock Horse Society Limited. Swabbing May Take Place.
- Neither the organising committee nor The Australian Stock Horse Society Limited accept any liability for any accident, damage injury or illness to horses, riders, beasts, grounds, spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever. Competitors whilst competing, do so at their own risk.
- The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or add to any classes if deemed necessary.
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any person, as they deem necessary.
- All entries must be financial members of the Australian Stock Horse Society. Proof of registration and current membership must be produced if required.
- The Judge's decision will be final. Any protest must be lodged in writing to the secretary within 30 minutes after the event. The complaint must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00, refundable if the protest is upheld.
- Colt/Stallion 2 years and over must be bitted at all times.
- No Refunds will be given unless accompanied by a vet or medical certificate within 7 days.
- All colts/stallions must be doubled tied and hobbled when not performing
- All classes to be ridden in snaffle bits.
- Junior Competitors (under 18 years of age) must wear an ASA approved equestrian helmet. No Stallions or Colts are allowed in Junior Classes.
- Novice Hack – A horse remains a novice until it has won three novices or an open hack class at any show, open gymkhana or similar event, except wins in youth, consolation or restricted age classes.

NEWCOMER ASH HACK

For registered ASH horses **who have not competed under saddle in ANY equestrian discipline**, prior to the 2024 Victorian State Championship Show (6th April 2024).

- To be judged as a ridden hack class, looking for three good paces, moderate collection, manners & paces and overall appearance of future ridden class potential.
- Season being – the day after the 2024 Victorian State Championships, to the day prior to the 2025 Victorian State Championships
- Each Victorian ASH Branch is to run a qualifying 'Newcomer' class at their branch show. A placing of 1st, 2nd or 3rd at a branch qualifier, will enable the horse and rider that qualified the horse to compete in the final.
- 1st place at a branch show can not compete in this class again until the final
- The final is to be run at the 2025 Victorian State Championships.

SEAMC HIGHPOINT – 1ST = 4pts, 2nd = 3pts, 3rd = 2pts, 4th = 1pt, Champion = 2pts, Reserve = 1pt.

Eligible classes, 2, 3, 7, 8, 11, 12, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 39, 40, 41, 42, 45.
(All Champions are eligible for VMC points.) The above classes are asterisked.

2 Handed Cutting and Working Cowhorse will be subject to entries.

Working Cowhorse sections of the 4yr Old Maturity & Open Challenge will be run on Saturday afternoon after the 2 Handed Cutting.

First 4 competitors to volunteer a horse for junior judging will receive 1 free show class entry. Must enter junior judging via Nominate.

JUDGES' BIOGRAPHIES

ALISON BOOTES and JESS McLEOD

Alison and Jess are mother and daughter, originally from the Upper Horton district of northern NSW, now residing in Yass NSW. Both have been involved in the Australian Stock Horse world since the early 2000s when Jess began competing in youth classes. As a youth competitor, Jess's highlights included twice Runner Up in the High Point Score at Sydney Royal Show, including winning the RAS Campdraft, Youth ASHLA, Youth Working, Youth Time Trial, Youth Station Horse, and the State Junior Judging competition all in the one year (2004). Jess then took a break from competition to attend university, and became an Accredited Level 1 Judge in 2011. Alison followed shortly afterwards, gaining accreditation in 2013. Taking a break from showing for several years during this time, both have campdrafted successfully up to Open wins. They also breed a small number of horses for personal use, under the prefix Wombiana.

As a rider, Alison was a very competitive hack rider and showjumper in her youth, winning Supreme Lady Rider awards at Sydney Royal. Returning to the showing world of ASHS relatively recently, Alison's competitive highlights include Reserve Champion Led ASH Mare at Canberra Royal 2022, ASHLA winner at Canberra Royal 2023, and runner up ASHLA in 2024, along with a multitude of Supreme Led and Supreme Ridden awards at various Ag and Branch Shows. Jess was also successful at Canberra Royal 2024, winning the Working ASH Gelding amongst other placings.

As a judge, Alison has presided over the NSW State Breeders Championships in Narrabri in 2018, Riverina Branch Show 2022, Northern Branch Show 2022, County of Cumberland Branch Show 2023, and Goulburn Murray Branch Show 2023, as well as many Ag Shows. Jess also judged at Northern Branch, County of Cumberland, and Goulburn Murray Branch Shows, and most recently judged at the 2024 NSW State Breeders Championships in Scone. Both have been nominated to judge at the ASHS Nationals in the past, however work commitments prevented us from accepting the nominations. Professionally, Jess works as a Veterinarian and Alison is retired.

JEN TODD

Jen is the Vice President of the South Coast Branch of the Australian Stock horse Society, with a strong commitment to the breed and its community. She has had the privilege of being mentored by Max and Lynne Gasser, respected figures in the Association whose support has shaped her knowledge and passion for Australian Stock Horses.

Jen has a strong interest in breeding and preserving the heritage of the breed and has spent years travelling to support her daughter, Teagan at show and campdraft arenas, including National and Royal Shows. She is an Accredited level 1 ASH Judge and particularly passionate about nurturing junior riders, recognizing their vital role as the future of the Australian Stock Horse Society.

RULES:

This event requires the use of a smooth snaffle bit. When quitting the cow in competition you must remove your hand from the reins and place on the horse's neck, failure to do so will incur a 1- point penalty. Loose reins are required; reins that are drawn too tight and excessive pulling on the horse's mouth will incur a 1- point penalty on each occasion. NOTE: This is a TWO -HANDED event only (Judge will discuss her requirements in relation to this event prior to commencement.)

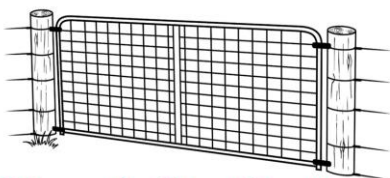
