***Restricted to Registered and Competition Eligible Australian Stock Horses and Financial Members of the Australian Stock Horse Society***

### Event 1. –WEEROONA FEEDLOT Encouragement Rider Challenge

**- Entry Fee \$60**

Restricted to riders 18 years and over, competitors MAY NOT have WON any of the following - ASH Open Age Stockman's Challenge, ASH encouragement, Futurity, Maturity or a similar non ASH Stockman's challenge with the exception of a Junior Rider or Juvenile Rider Stockman's challenge. This will include any win in an Open Age Campdraft (i.e. Maiden, Novice, Open, Ladies, Associate) or a Restricted campdraft .

- DRY WORK 2925 WP1 - Ribbons to 4<sup>th</sup>
- WET WORK **AS PER ASHS CHALLENGE RULES** – Ribbons to 4<sup>th</sup>
- Time Trial – **TTP2** – Ribbons to 4<sup>th</sup>

**All competitors are strongly advised to refer to the Australian Stock Horse Society Limited Events Rules and Regulations for ASH Stockman's Challenge as published in the event rules handbook pages . These rules will apply. Subject to any changes that may be made by the committee.**

1. If competing more than one horse, please ensure that you have enough handlers for each horse.
2. Horses must compete in all phases to be eligible for overall placing.
3. No substitution of horses once the event has commenced.
4. The Judge's decision is final. Any disputes must be lodged with the Secretary in writing within 1 Hour of the Class and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee which is refundable should the dispute be upheld.
5. The decision of the Committee on all matters will be final and binding.
6. The Committee reserves the right to substitute products for prize money.
7. The Committee reserves the right to vary the program at any time.
8. Neither the organising committee nor the Australian Stock Horse Society Limited accept any responsibility for any accident, damage, injury or illness to Horses, riders, beasts, ground, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
9. The Australian Stock Horse Society upholds high standards for Horse Welfare and Cattle Welfare, the committee will act as welfare officers and should anyone be seen to breach our policies the welfare officers have the authority to approach the alleged offender and ask them to cease behaviour and or leave the Venue. The use of drugs of any kind are not permitted under Horse Welfare Rules
