



- Prize Money for overall challenge place winners 1st -5th
- All overall winners will receive cotton ripstop combo rug.
- Prizes also for individual challenge events 1st-3rd.
- All competitors must be ASHS Members before competition.
- Temporary memberships will be available on the day.
- To be eligible, all horses must be owned by a current financial ASHS member
- Horses Nominated in 8/U13 & 13/U18Challenge are the only horses exempt from being ASH Registered.
- All horses entered in each challenge must complete all events or forfeit all points gained.
- Encouragement Challenge is for riders that have not won a Challenge, Futurity or Maturity at National, State or Branch level.
- Any horse winning a section of a Challenge does not change its competitive status for that event, i.e., working, hack, campdraft, etc.
- A nominated horse must have the same rider throughout all phases of the challenge.
- Horses nominated in the age restricted classes will take their age from 1st August.
- Horses may be checked alongside their papers.
- All horses competing must be ridden in a snaffle bit with a smooth mouthpiece, minimum diameter is 10mm or 3/8". No twisted wire bits or rough surfaces, no tie downs.
- Bridle and saddle choice is personal preference but must be safe for use, no Horned Saddles.
- Anybody displaying acts of cruelty towards a horse or other livestock will be asked to leave the grounds and further action will be taken.
- The Judges' decision Is final, there will be no protests allowed.
- All competitors under the age of 18 must wear an approved helmet and other riders are encouraged to do so.
- Riders under 18 years of age are not to handle or ride a colt or a stallion.
- Colts and stallions are to be double tied unless they are in a stallion box.
- Stables are limited, first in basis. A flat rate of \$20 for camping and stables will be added to all entries
- No electric fencing permitted.
- Power and water available. Please bring generator limited Power sites, toilet, and shower blocks on the grounds.
- Entry fees will NOT be refunded under any circumstances unless received in written form at least 72 hours prior to the event, with vet/ medical certificate.
